

DAY 1 – Arrival Switzerland

Individual travel to Zürich. Zürich, the “metropolis of experiences,” offers a unique mixture of attractions that you can enjoy by yourself on the your first day.

Overnight in Zürich.

DAY 2 – Zürich – St. Gallen (ca. 93 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

On your way to St. Gallen stopover at the Rhine Falls, Europe’s largest waterfall. In St. Gallen the Abbey precinct with the cathedral and Abbey Library has been accorded UNESCO World Heritage listing and belongs to the top attractions along the Grand Tour.

Overnight in St. Gallen.

DAY 3 – St. Gallen – Davos (ca.100 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

On your way to Davos you will pass the village of Appenzell. The Appenzell region is known for rural customs and traditions. Continue your drive and have a stopover at Heidi’s Village in Maienfield.

Overnight in Davos.

DAY 4 – Davos – Lugano (ca. 180 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Today’s journey takes you to Lugano in the south of Switzerland, where you have several opportunities to experience the Grand Tour attractions. We recommend a stroll around the historical old-town and an excursion to Sa Salvatore or Monte Bre.

Overnight in Lugano.

DAY 5 – Lugano – Zermatt (ca. 133 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Leaving Lugano for Zermatt. On your way lies Ascona. Continue moving down to Tasch which is your last stop by car before you continue by train to Zermatt.

Overnight in Zermatt.

DAY 6 – Zermatt – Montreaux (ca. 93 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

A morning trip up the exhilarating open-air Gornergrat railway is not to be missed. Back in Tasch your route begins with a stunning drive up through the Valais, heading through Sion, Martigny and Aigle. Continue along the shores of Lake Geneva to Montreaux.

Overnight in Montreaux.

DAY 7 – Montreaux – Gstaad (ca. 205 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Drive through the orchards and terraced vineyards of the Lavaux to Lausanne and from here continue your drive to Freiburg. Further on your way you will pass the Greizer region, with its rolling green landscape.

Overnight in Gstaad.

DAY 8 – Gstaad – Lucerne (ca. 195 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

Continue your drive to Interlaken. From Interlaken you can experience the majestic Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau summits. If you have some time left before you head to Lucerne, Berne, UNESCO World Heritage is the place to spend it.

Overnight in Lucerne.

DAY 9 – Lucerne – Zürich (ca. 86 miles)

Breakfast at the hotel.

You will spend your last day in one of the most beautiful cities in Switzerland. One of the highlights of Lucerne is the Chapel Bridge. Drive back to Zürich for rental car drop-off at the airport and return journey.
