You’ll also visit the gazebo made famous in the classic film *The Sound of Music*.

Salzburg Walking & Coach Tour with *The Sound of Music* Locations

Dinner at St. Peter’s Stiftskeller with Entertainment

Sit down for a private dinner at St. Peter’s Stiftskeller, known as the oldest restaurant in Europe, with mentions of it dating back to the year 803.

Option A:

Private Tour of the Eishöle Ice Cave

Enter a hole in the mountainside for a self-guided tour of the largest ice cave in the world! Walk through Eishöle Ice Cave—also known as the Eisriesenwelt, which translates into “World of Ice Giants”—and be awestruck by breathtaking ice formations, including crystals, towers and walls. Look for the ethereal Alexander von Mörk Cathedral and the Ice Palace to behold the extraordinary beauty of ice reflected in cascading waterfalls.

Afterwards, enjoy a delicious lunch at Oedl House Restaurant located at the Ice Cave.

Option B:

Organic Farm & Cheesery Tour

Delight your senses on this tour of Fürstenhof, an organic farm and cheesery with a charming shop. Enjoy a guided walk through of the farm and savor a tasting while trying your own hand at cheese-making.

Afterwards, head to Hohenwerfen Castle for lunch at Burg Hohenwerfen where you'll dine in the castle's idyllic garden setting.

Hohenwerfen Castle Tour with Falconry Show

Tour this 900-year-old fortified castle that makes the Middle Ages come to life! Explore the castle's hidden corners on a guided tour, then marvel at a magnificent falconry show.

Afternoon & Dinner On Your Own in Salzburg

Explore this stunning city on your own as you stroll vibrant streets lined with shops and Baroque architecture. The Altstadt, or Old City, is the birthplace of famed composer Mozart, which is preserved as a museum displaying some of his childhood instruments.
